John 3:16 (Happy Birthday Jesus! Thank you for your gift that we celebrate today)

For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

Day 2

Luke 10:1 (God does not mean for us to go out alone instead with a partner and friend)

When Jesus sent out the seventy-two he sent them out two by two to act as front runners for him. Each pair was to go ahead to the towns Jesus was going to visit.

Day 3

1 Corinthians 15 (HE rose so we could have life)

The Resurrection of Christ

Now, brothers and sisters, I want to remind you of the gospel I preached to you, which you received and on which you have taken your stand. By this gospel you are saved, if you hold firmly to the word I preached to you. Otherwise, you have believed in vain.

For what I received I passed on to you as of first importance: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, that he was buried, that he was raised on the third day according to the Scriptures,

Day 4

Genesis 1:19 (No matter what happened yesterday or today, tomorrow brings hope - each day has a new beginning to be joyful)

Day 5

Matthew 14:19 - If Jesus can feed 5000 people with 5 loaves of bread, know that he will always provide for you in your time of need.

And he directed the people to sit down on the grass. Taking the five loaves and the two fish and looking up to heaven, he gave thanks and broke the loaves. Then he gave them to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the people.

Day 6

Day 7

Matthew 18:21-22 There is no limit to the number of times we must forgive and how we must keep our hearts on what is good and positive and not on what is negative and prevents us from loving others.

The Parable of the Unmerciful Servant

Then Peter came to Jesus and asked, "Lord, how many times shall I forgive my brother or sister who sins against me? Up to seven times?" Jesus answered, "I tell you, not seven times, but seventy-seven times.[a]



1 Peter 3:20 There is freedom and security from God through obedience

Day 11 Acts 1:26 God will always seek to add to His number of followers and believers. We have hope in being welcomed into God's family regardless of our circumstances.

"Then they cast lots and the lot fell to Matthias; so he was added to the eleven apostles."

Day 12 Mark 6:43 God will always seek to complete his promises. He will bring together all that is broken to bring completion to this plan.
